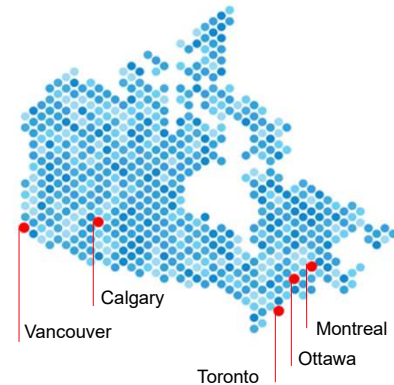

Delays at the TMO: Perfect Storm



New Canadian Trademarks Act

- Completely overhauled in 2019
- Significant substantive and procedural changes



Madrid Protocol

- Delays while Trademark examiners came up to speed
- The top five recipients of designations: the U.K., the E.U., the U.S., China, and **Canada**



COVID-19 pandemic operational disruptions

- TMO was paper-based
- No Examiner's Reports were issued during several lockdowns

Dates of Trademark Applications being distributed for Examination

Applications not using the Pre-approved List of Goods and Services: **March 27th, 2019**

} **50 months**

Applications using the Pre-Approved List of Goods and Services: **October 21st, 2021**

Madrid (based on date of WIPO notification of designation): **February 3, 2022**

} **16 months***

**Note: faster initial examination, but much slower subsequent examination*

Expedited examination

- The **FASTEST** way to have a Canadian trademark application examined
- If granted, examination typically takes place within **1-2 weeks** of the request
- **Affidavit evidence** from the applicant is required, demonstrating that the applicant is:
 - Contemplating or has commenced **court action in Canada**;
 - Combating **counterfeit products** at the **Canadian** border; OR
 - Seeking to protect its rights from being **severely disadvantaged** on **online marketplaces**.

A court action

- A court action is **expected** or **underway in Canada** with respect to the trademark in association with the goods or services in the application
- Affidavit must refer to the **litigation** that has been **commenced** or which is **expected** to be commenced in respect of the trademark
- CIPO was initially **lenient** with respect to the meaning of “**expected**” court action
- However, CIPO’s stance has **tightened**, and if relying on an expected court action, **details** need to be provided in the affidavit
 - Factual background – no need to identify parties by name
 - Steps taken in anticipation of litigation

Combating counterfeit products

- The applicant is in the process of combating **counterfeit products** at the **Canadian** border with respect to the trademark in association with the goods or services in the application
- Affidavit should state that the applicant requires a **registration** to record its rights with the **CBSA** (which only **records** registered marks)
- Affidavit may refer to the **anti-counterfeiting** actions taken by the applicant
 - If the applicant has a **history** of dealing with counterfeit activity and/or an **established anti-counterfeiting program**, the details may be useful to include – while **not required** (and we have been successful without such details), it can be beneficial to an applicant’s request

Disadvantaged on online marketplaces

- The applicant requires registration of its trademark in order to protect its intellectual property rights from being **severely disadvantaged** on **online marketplaces**
- Common **examples** include infringers / counterfeiters on **Amazon** and **Ebay**, but other examples can be used
- Affidavit should provide a **background** and **history** of the applicant's online commerce business, the **activities of the infringer**, and the **steps taken by the applicant**
- **Screenshots** of the objectionable listings / posts / sites **advertising** the counterfeit goods may be appended as **exhibits** to the affidavit

COVID-19 products and services

- The goods or services are **medical** goods or services that **prevent, diagnose, treat or cure COVID-19**
 - Includes pharmaceuticals, medical devices and protective equipment, medical services, medical research services
- Application must include **at least one** of these goods / services
- Applicant must also have **obtained approval** or **submitted a request for approval** for use of the goods or services listed in the application to **Health Canada** under the same name as the trademark.

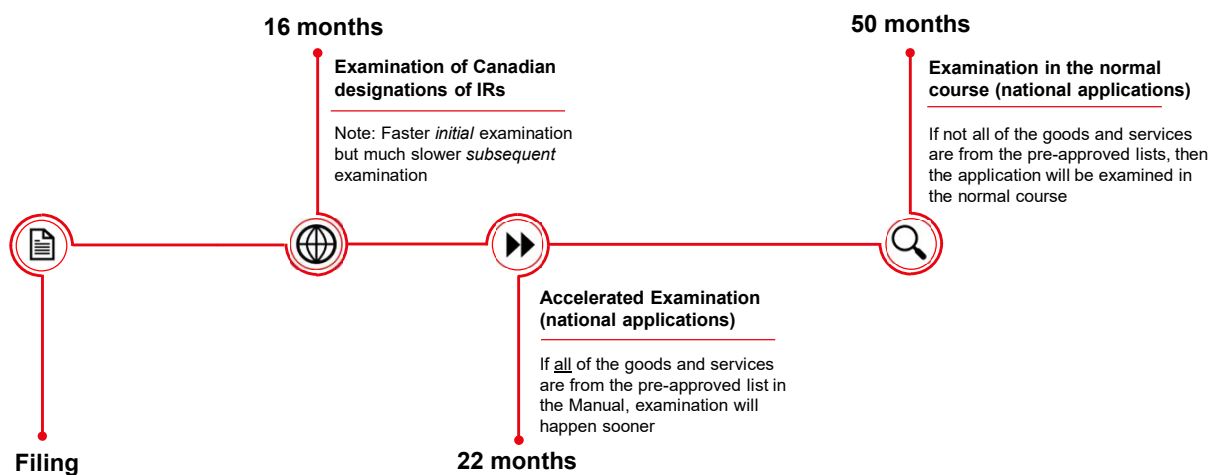
Conclusion on expedited examination

- While it is the **fastest** way to examination, it is **likely not available** to the majority of brand owners
- However, given the **massive benefit** which it offers, applicants are well-advised to consider whether **any of the aforementioned criteria** apply to their cases
- Cost is **not prohibitive** in most cases; there is **no official fee**, but does require **legal fees** for preparation of the affidavit and submission of the request
- **Success** rate is currently very high – **90+%** of requests we have submitted have been **approved** for expedited examination!

Benefits of using the G&S Manual

- ✓ Examination accelerated **automatically**
- ✓ Examination is accelerated *even if* terms are subsequently retired from Manual
- ✓ May avoid the issuance of an Examiner's Report

Improvements in Accelerated Examination

- The list of pre-approved goods and services has been **significantly expanded**
- CIPO's software has been updated to improve functionality
 - For example:**
 - The terms "**t-shirts**" and "**pants**" are on the pre-approved list in the Manual, but "**clothing, namely, t-shirts and pants**" is not
 - Previously, examination of an application covering "**clothing, namely, t-shirts and pants**" would *not* be accelerated
 - Now, examination would be **accelerated** since updated software can detect that the terms after "namely" are on the pre-approved list
- Pre-assessment letters will identify which goods and services are on the pre-approved list

Accelerated Examination

- Descriptions of goods and services **do not** have to be drawn from the pre-approved lists in the Manual to be acceptable, for example:
 - “snowblowers” on the pre-approved list in the Manual → examination **accelerated**
 - “snowblowers and parts therefor” not on the pre-approved list → acceptable, but **no accelerated examination**



Tips: If you want accelerated examination – but don't want to amend or select all descriptions from pre-approved list? Consider:

- **Divisional** application
- Requesting that **terms be added** to the Manual
- Requesting **approval for Custom List of goods or services**

Tips for Accelerating Examination

Example:

- Application covers ten goods or services → **six** are on the pre-approved list, **four** are not on the pre-approved list

Options for accelerating examination:

- File a **divisional application** – available since June 2019

Parent Application:
six goods/services on
the pre-approved list



Examination **accelerated**
(22 months)

Divisional Application:
four goods/services not
on the pre-approved list



Examination **in the normal**
course (50 months)

Tips for Accelerating Examination

19

Example:

- Application covers ten goods or services → **six** are on the pre-approved list, **four** are not on the pre-approved list

Option for accelerating examination:

- Request that the goods or services be **added to the Manual**
 - TMO will consider requests for goods and services to be added to the Manual
 - Goods and services can be submitted in English or French
 - Processing time → **3 weeks** from receipt to publication in the Manual

Tips for Accelerating Examination

Example:

- Application covers a long list of goods or services, which will also be used by the applicant for future applications

Option for accelerating examination:

- Request approval for **custom list** of goods or services
 - The Office will review requests for custom lists of goods and services
 - Certain terms from the custom list may be added to the Manual
 - Note: custom list must be approved **before** the application is filed
